Where Every Festival Tells a Story

1. Cholistan Desert Jeep Rally

"Where Speed Meets Heritage"

Dates: Annually in February (typically mid-February).

Location: Cholistan Desert near Derawar Fort.



2. Sarfaranga Cold Desert Jeep Rally

"Race the Heights of Skardu"

Dates: Annually in August (mid to late August).

Location: Skardu.



3. Uchal Festival

"Celebrate Nature's Bounty with the Kalash"

Dates: Around 15–16 July (some variations into August).

Location: Kalash Valley.



4. Shandur Polo Festival

"Experience Polo at the Roof of the World"

Dates: 7 – 9 July (Annually).

Location: Shandur, Chitral.



5. Baba Ghundi Festival

"Honoring Spiritual Heritage in Upper Hunza"

Dates: Mid-August (around 14–16 August).

Location: Gojal, Upper Hunza.



6. International Silk Route Festival

"Journey Through Hunza's Timeless Traditions"

Dates: Early to mid-October.

Location: Hunza.



7. Mayfung Festival Rally

Celebrate Renewal and Winter Spirit in Baltistan

Dates: December 21st.

Location: Baltistan.



8. Chawmos Festival

Kalash Winter Solstice: Rituals, Feasts, and Joy

Dates: Around 14–22 December.

Location: Kalash Valley.



9. Winter Lude Festival Hunza

Snow, Sports, and Culture Unite in Hunza

Dates: January – February.

Location: Hunza.



10. Ski Festival Malam Jabba

Shred the Slopes – Ski into Winter Adventure

Dates: January – February.

Location: Malam Jabba, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.



11. Cherry Blossom Festival Hunza

Spring in Bloom: Hunza's Cherry Wonderland

Dates: March – April (Peak mid-March to early April).

Location: Hunza.



12. Chilam Joshi Festival

Kalash Spring: Dance, Rituals, and Celebration

Dates: 13 – 16 May (Annually, Date may Change).

Location: Kalash Valley.



13. Ginani Festival

Harvest Joy: Celebrate Hunza's Wheat Season

Dates: Late June – Early July.

Location: Hunza.
